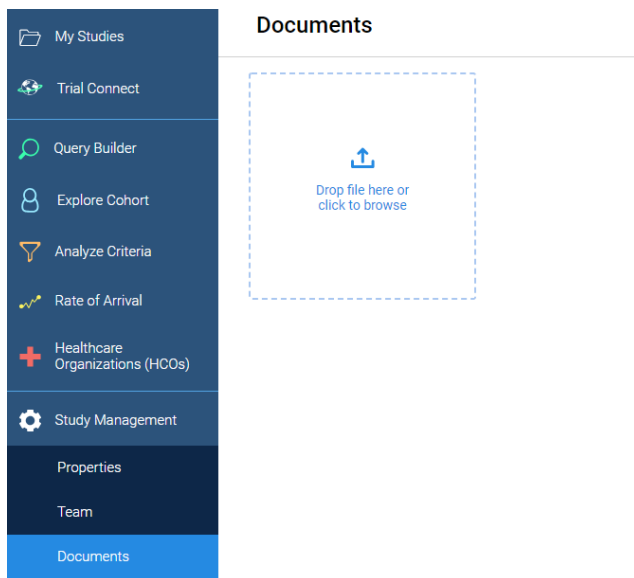


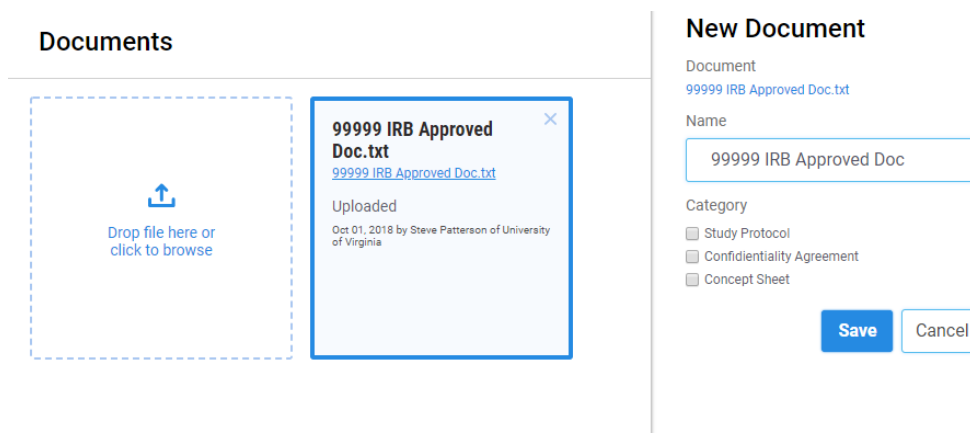
TriNetX Live gives Researchers the ability to perform study feasibility analysis on de-identified data/limited data set, then at a certain point, request the MRN numbers of the patients behind the TriNetX query. If the research is Human Subject Research (visit link [here](#)), IRB approval is needed and documentation must be attached to the request below.

Once a researcher has the desired cohort defined within TriNetX and has received IRB approval (for Human Subject Research), by following these steps, they can obtain the list of MRNs of the patient cohort.

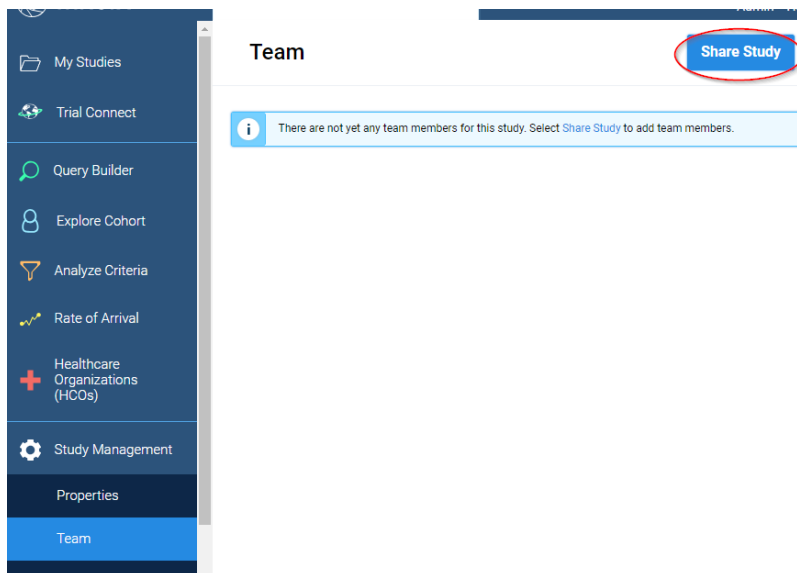
1. If the research is Human Subject Research, go to Step 2. If research is not Human Subject Research, skip to Step 4.
2. Within the “Study Management” menu, select “Documents”. Click within the “Drop file here or click to browse” option on your screen and attach the complete IRB-approved documentation that either states you are authorized to see MRNs or the IRB Exemption Letter.



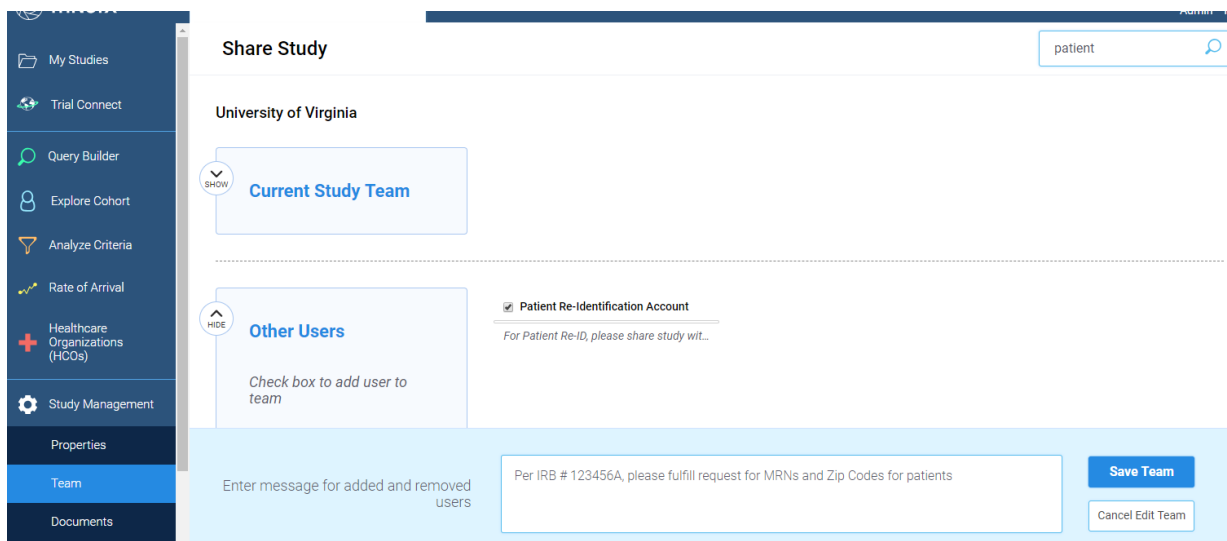
3. After you see the document’s name in your “Documents” screen, name it appropriately and select “Save”.



- Within the “Study Management” Menu, select “Team” then “Share Study”



- In the search box in the upper right of your screen, type “Patient” then select “Patient Re-Identification Account” next to “Other Users”. Within the message box labelled “Enter message for added and removed users”, enter what data you are specifically asked for (that is governed by the attached IRB documentation) and the precise location within the IRB document specifying the data elements you are allowed to see/use. Select “Save Team” then “Confirm” to make request.
